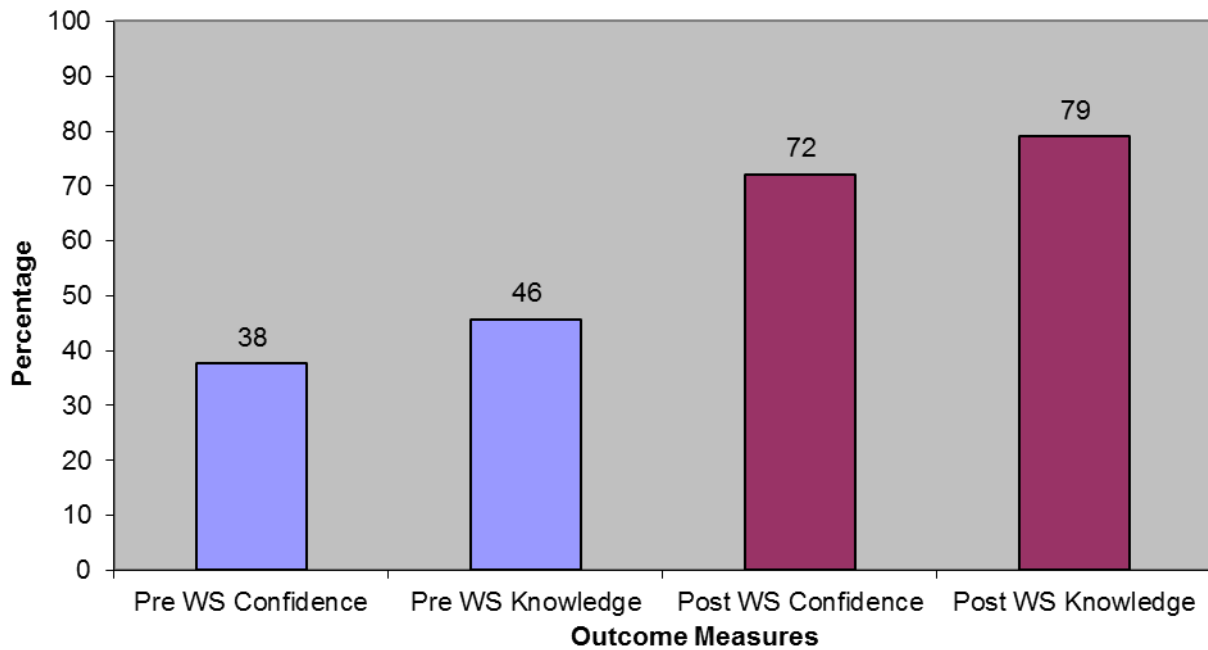

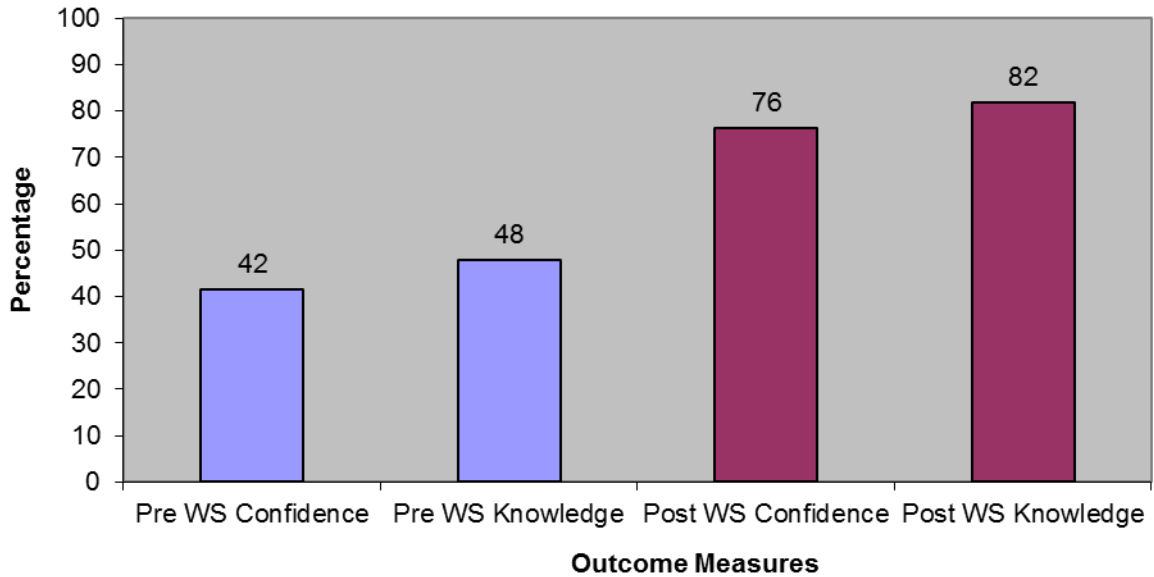

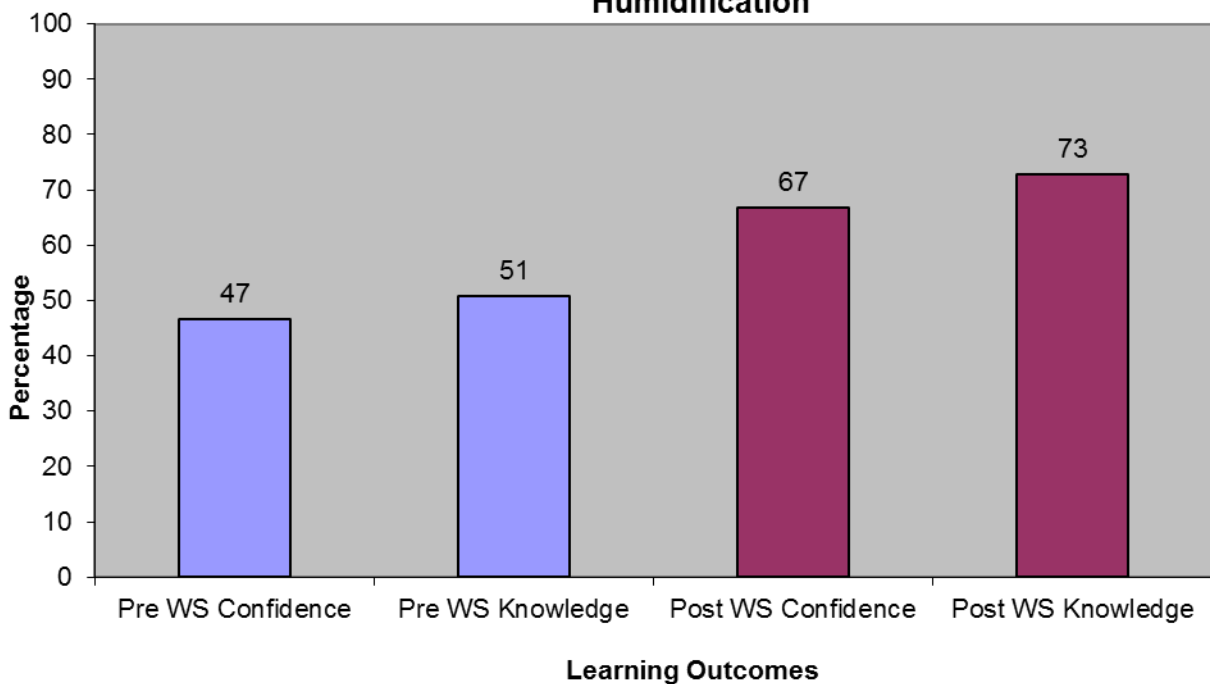

**Speech Work Station 1 Tubes & Valves**



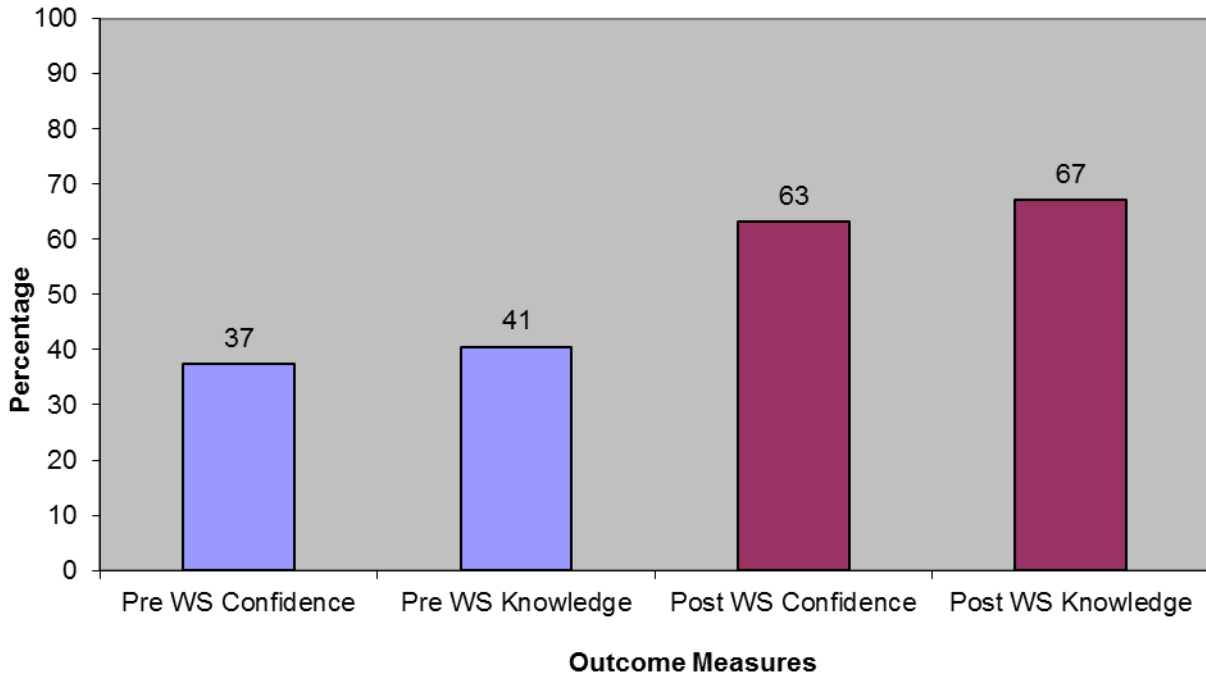

**Physio Work Station 2 Principles of O2 Therapy & Humidification**



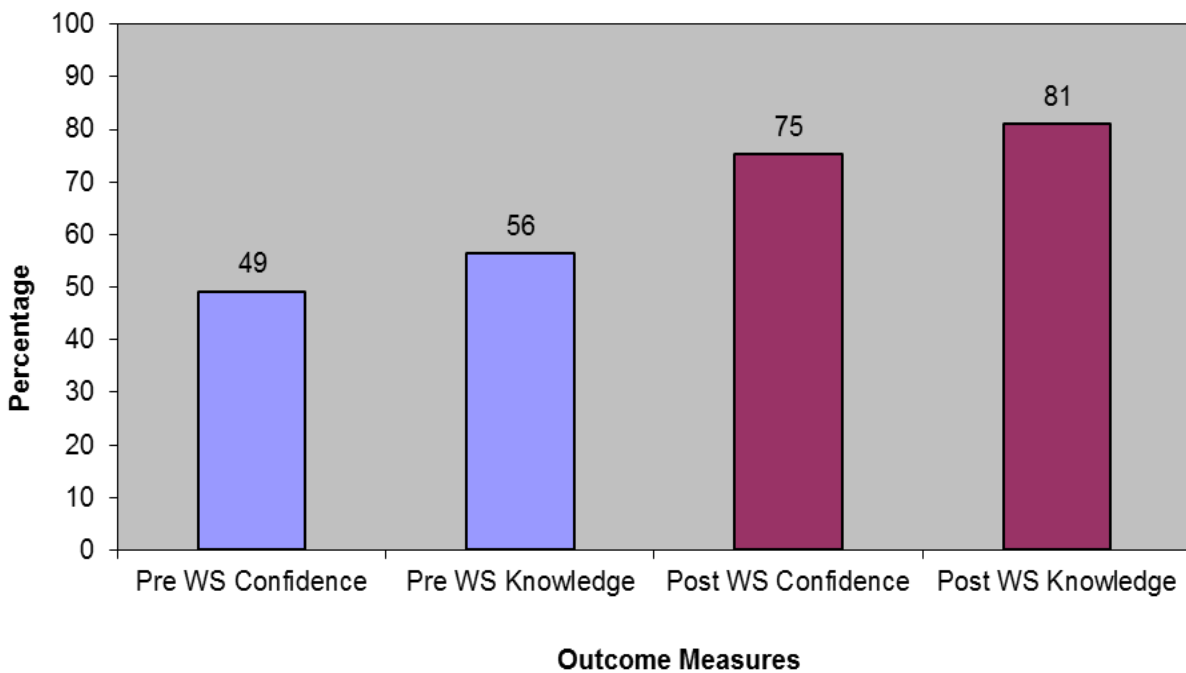
